



EMERGENCY FUND

Over the past year EMBRACE has distributed over £1700 to meet a range of needs through partner organisations such as NICRAS, The Welcome Centre, Homeplus, Bryson One Stop Shop, Chinese Welfare Association, BELB Education Welfare, South Tyrone Empowerment Programme. In every case there was no recourse to public funds to meet the presenting needs. These needs have included:

- Flights home for destitute migrant workers to a range of countries including Bulgaria, Romania, Portugal, Slovakia, Poland and the Czech Republic and bus fares for people seeking asylum to travel to England.
- Hostel accommodation and food for many asylum seekers and destitute migrant workers as well as for some people who were waiting repatriation by IOM.
- Paying school bus fares for Roma children in South Belfast who would otherwise not be able to attend secondary school and for a school uniform for another child who was seeking asylum.
