The workshops are supported by funding from the Office of the First Minister and Deputy First Minister (OFMDFM), and the Churches.

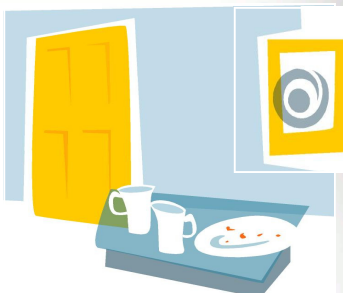
